

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
VILLAGE OF ANDALUSIA, ILLINOIS
ZONING BOARD OF APPEALS**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a Public Hearing will be held by the Zoning Board of Appeals of the Village of Andalusia, Rock Island County, Illinois, on **October 13, 2026**, at the hour of **7:00 PM**, at the Andalusia Village Hall located at **221 1st St, Andalusia, IL 61232**.

The purpose of the Public Hearing is to consider and hear public testimony regarding a proposed Text Amendment to the Village of Andalusia Zoning Ordinance. The proposed amendment intends to modify regulations within the **AG-1 Agricultural District** to permit the keeping of traditional livestock and barn animals as an accessory use, subject to the following criteria:

1. A mandatory minimum parcel size of **fifteen (15) contiguous acres** under common ownership.
2. Established animal stocking density limitations per acre for large livestock, medium livestock, and poultry.
3. A strict **prohibition on exotic, wild, and dangerous animals**, as well as specific noisy poultry species including roosters, turkeys, and peacocks.
4. Setback regulations requiring animal housing structures to be located at least **300 feet** from off-site residential dwellings and **200 feet** from adjacent residential property lines.
5. Mandatory on-site sanitation, manure management, and environmental runoff controls.

All interested parties, residents, and owners of property within the corporate limits of the Village of Andalusia will be given an opportunity to be heard, express oral comments, or submit written text concerning the proposed amendment at the time and place designated above.

A draft copy of the proposed text amendment is on file and available for public review at the office of the Village Clerk during normal regular business hours.
