Buildings & Grounds: Trustee Yakovich reported that there is a tube in the dike that needs to be repaired. Justin Parchert reported that he has some work to do on our flood gates.

Harbor: Trustee Kelly reported that the Harbor is flooded, hopefully the water will go down soon.

REPORTS OF OFFICERS:

Village Clerk: Clerk Hoffman reminded the Trustees that we will be preparing the appropriations ordinance within the next couple of weeks. She told them to start thinking about projects for the upcoming year.

Clerk Hoffman also asked if the Mayor and Trustees want to balance the accounts that are in the negative with the exception of the Harbor Fund.

Public Works Director: Justin Parchert reported that he has a bid for asphalt for 7th avenue east from Taylor Ridge Paving. He’s hoping to get at least 2 more bids.

Justin has been working on the back hoe. He ordered a few parts. He's hoping to get it back up and running shortly.

Justin reported on the flood. This one took us by surprise. There was no flood predicted this Spring. The flood gates are working, but a few of them are leaking. Justin will be addressing them as soon as he can.

Justin also reported that we need to do some pipe lining on the west side of the flood dike.

We have all the permits in for the seawall project. Once the water goes down, we will be able to get it started.

Mayor: Nothing to report

Citizen Comments: Bill Campbell would like to put up a 250-year flag at the Lion's Park. He repaired the faulty pull rope at his own expense. He also donated the flag.

Bill also asked if he could put a small bridge over the ditch at his sister's house. The Trustees agreed as long as it doesn't interfere with the ditch or the snowplow.
