

CHAPTER 5

VILLAGE PRESIDENT

SECTION:

- 1-5-1: Election; Term of Office
- 1-5-2: Duties
- 1-5-3: Bond, Oath, Salary
- 1-5-4: President Pro Tem

1-5-1: ELECTION; TERM OF OFFICE: The Village President shall be elected for a term of four (4) years, and he shall be the President of the Board of Trustees as is provided by Statute. (M.C. 1949; Sec. 1)

1-5-2: DUTIES:

(A) Duties: He shall be the chief executive officer of the Village, and he shall perform all duties that may be required of him by Statute or ordinance. He shall have supervision over all executive officers of the Village, and he shall have the power and the authority to inspect all books and records kept by any Village officer or employee at any reasonable time. (M.C. 1949; Sec. 1)

(B) Designation of Duties: Whenever there is a question as to the respective duties or powers of any appointed officer of the Village, this shall be settled by the President; and he shall have the power to delegate to any such officer any duty which is to be performed when no specific officer has been directed to perform that duty. (M.C. 1949; Sec. 3)

1-5-3: BOND, OATH, SALARY: Before entering upon the duties of his office the President shall give a bond with sureties to be approved by the Board of Trustees conditioned upon the faithful performance of his duties; in the sum of at least three thousand dollars (\$3,000.00) or such higher sum as may be directed by the Board of Trustees. He shall take the oath of the office prescribed by Statute, and shall receive such compensation as may be set from time to time by the Board. (M.C. 1949; Sec. 4)

1-5-4: PRESIDENT PRO TEM: During a temporary absence or disability of the Village President the Board of Trustees shall elect one of its number to act as President Pro Tem, who during the absence or disability of the President shall perform the duties pertaining to the office. (M.C. 1949; Sec. 5)
