

CHAPTER 14

VILLAGE JAIL

1-14-1: ESTABLISHMENT: The place in the Village heretofore established and used as the jail, or any other place which may be hereafter established by the Board of Trustees for that purpose, is hereby declared to be the Village Jail. (M.C. 1949; Sec. 99)

1-14-2: KEEPER: The Chief of Police shall be the keeper of the Jail and shall have custody over all persons confined therein and of all property pertaining thereto. (M.C. 1949; Sec. 100)

1-14-3: PRISONERS: The Jail shall be used for incarceration of all persons arrested for violating any laws of the State of Illinois, the United States or for violating any provision of this Code until such person shall be lawfully brought before the proper officer for a hearing or until such person shall be lawfully transferred to some other place of incarceration or otherwise lawfully released. 1-14-4: ESCAPE: It shall be unlawful for any person to escape, attempt to escape, or to assist any prisoner to escape or attempt to escape from the Jail. (M.C. 1949; Sec. 102)

1-14-5: COMMUNICATIONS WITH PRISONERS: It shall be unlawful for any person to communicate with any prisoner held in the Jail without the permission of the Chief of Police. (M.C. 1949; Sec. 103)

1-14-6: PENALTY: Any person violating any of the provisions of this Chapter shall be fined not less than one dollar (\$1.00) nor more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for each offense. (M.C. 1949; Sec. 104)
