

CHAPTER 1

BOARD OF HEALTH

2-1-1: APPOINTMENT: There is hereby created the Board of Health for the Village. The Board of Health shall consist of three (3) members, the Health Officer and two (2) other members who shall be appointed by the President by and with the advice and consent of the Board of Trustees. (M.C. 1949, Sec. 47)

2-1-2: GENERAL DUTIES: The Board of Health shall have the powers and perform the duties assigned to it by Statute or ordinance. It shall be the duty of the Board of Health to enforce all provisions of this Code which relate to public health, or relate to nuisances.

The Board of Health shall make all necessary rules and regulations for the protection of the health of the Village and guard against the spread of contagious diseases and to prevent by necessary rules the induction of diseases, contagious or otherwise, within the corporate limits of the Village. (M.C. 1949, Sec. 48)

2-1-3: QUARANTINE; VACCINATION: The Board of Health is hereby authorized to make such reasonable rules as may be necessary regarding quarantine and vaccination, for the prevention of the spread of contagious diseases, and to quarantine premises where such diseases occur for such time as may be necessary to protect public health. (M.C. 1949, Sec. 49)

2-1-4: ORDERS; NOTICES: Any person violating or refusing to obey any order of the Board of Health or destroying or mutilating or concealing any notice posted by or under the authority of the Board of Health shall be fined not less than ten dollars (\$10.00) nor more than fifty dollars (\$50.00) for each offense.
