

CHAPTER 5

BOWLING ALLEYS

SECTION:

- 3-5-1: License Required
- 3-5-2: Fee
- 3-5-3: Hours of Operation
- 3-5-4: Penalty

3-5-1: LICENSE REQUIRED: No person shall operate or maintain a bowling alley open to the public without having first obtained a license therefor. Applications for such licenses shall be made in writing to the Clerk and shall state thereon the intended location of the place of business and the number of alleys to be used. (M.C. 1949; Sec. 186)

3-5-2: FEE: The annual fee for such licenses shall be twenty five dollars (\$25.00) for each alley. (M.C. 1949; Sec. 187)

3-5-3: HOURS FOR OPERATION: No bowling alley shall be kept open for business, or used, between the hours of twelve o'clock (12:00) midnight and six o'clock (6:00) in the morning. (M.C. 1949; Sec. 188)

3-5-4: PENALTY: Any person violating any provision of this Chapter shall be fined not less than five dollars (\$5.00) nor more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for each offense; and a separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day during or on which a violation occurs or continues. (M.C. 1949; Sec. 189)
