

CHAPTER 6

CIRCUSES

3-6-1: LICENSE REQUIRED: No person shall conduct or operate a circus in the Village without having first obtained a license as is provided in this Chapter. Applications for such licenses shall be made to the Clerk and shall specify the place in or on which the circus is to be conducted. (M.C. 1949; Sec. 190)

3-6-2: FEE: The fee for such licenses shall be fifteen dollars (\$15.00) per day. Street parades of circuses, two dollars fifty cents (\$2.50) per day. (M.C. 1949; Sec. 191)

3-6-3: SIDE SHOWS, CONCESSIONS: The license fee for each side show and concession operated in connection with the circus shall be as set by the Board of Trustees. (M.C. 1949; Sec. 192)

3-6-4: PROVISIONS TO BE OBEYED: It shall be the duty of every person licensed under this Chapter to obey the provisions of Chapter 3 of this Title and all other Code provisions relating to circuses or the premises occupied. (M.C. 1949; Sec. 193)

3-6-5: INSPECTIONS: It shall be the duty of the Chief of Police or the Fire Chief to see that inspections as provided for in Chapter 3 of this Title shall be made of all circuses, circus performances and of the premises used. (M.C. 1949; Sec. 194)

3-6-6: CHEATING: It shall be unlawful for any person to cheat, short change or otherwise defraud any person attending or about to attend a circus performance within the Village. (M.C. 1949; Sec. 195)

3-6-7: BOND: It shall be unlawful to conduct any parade connected with a circus on any public street, alley or other public way or place in the Village, unless a permit therefor is first obtained from the Board of Trustees. Such permit shall specify the route to be followed, and shall be accompanied by a bond in the sum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00), conditioned to indemnify the Village for any loss, damage or liability incurred or caused by the conduct of such exhibition or such parade. 3-6-8: PENALTY: Any person violating any provision of this Chapter shall be fined not less than twenty five dollars (\$25.00) nor more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00) for each offense; and a separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day during or on which a violation occurs or continues. (M.C. 1949, Sec. 197; amd. Ord. 338, 1-3-77)
