

CHAPTER 27

SMALL ENGINE-APPLIANCE REPAIR SHOPS

3-27-1: DEFINITION: A small engine-appliance repair shop is any place of business where mechanical or electrical repairs consisting of cutting, drilling, boring, grinding, shaping, fabricating, bending, brazing, soldering, or welding are performed.

3-27-2: LICENSE REQUIRED: It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to conduct or operate a small engine-appliance repair shop without having first obtaining a license or permit therefor.

Fee: The annual fee for such license or permit shall be twenty five dollars (\$25.00).

3-27-3: CARE AND ATTENDANCE: Gasoline or other highly flammable liquids and materials shall be kept in proper containers. All electrical machinery shall be used in a safe manner with respect to the electrical capacities of the facility. Gasoline driven machinery shall be operated in a well ventilated area. Premises must be kept neat and clean, free from rubbish, trash, and possible hazardous objects. In addition, the shop must follow OSHA guidelines for operations.

3-27-4: FIRE EXTINGUISHERS: All small engine-appliance repair shops shall be equipped with at least one chemical fire extinguisher suitable for oil, gasoline, and electrical fires.

3-27-5: HOURS OF OPERATION: No shop shall operate in the nighttime between the hours of eight o'clock (8:00) P.M., and six o'clock (6:00) A.M., when buildings within four hundred feet (400') are used for residential purposes.

3-27-6: INSPECTIONS: It shall be the duty of the Health Inspector to make periodical inspections to insure compliance with the provisions of this Chapter.

3-27-7: PENALTY: Any said business violating any provisions of this Chapter shall be fined not less than five dollars (\$5.00) nor more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00) for each offense. Such license may be revoked or suspended for repeated violations at any time. (Ord. 369, 4-7-80)
