

CHAPTER 6

PLUMBING

4-6-1: PERMIT REQUIRED: No plumbing shall be installed in any place in the Village unless a permit therefor is obtained. Applications for such permits shall be made to the Clerk and shall state thereon the name of the person or contractor intended to have charge of the installation. (M.C. 1949, Sec. 526)

4-6-2: INSPECTIONS: The Plumbing Inspector shall make or cause to be made such inspections as may be necessary to insure compliance with the provisions of this Chapter. (M.C. 1949, Sec. 527)

4-6-3: TESTS: All plumbing fixtures installed shall be subjected to either the air or water test, under the supervision of the Plumbing Inspector. (M.C. 1949, Sec. 528)

4-6-4: SPECIFICATIONS: All plumbing fixtures installed must be trapped, and all plumbing shall be properly vented. Traps and vents shall conform to the specifications approved from time to time by ordinance, and a copy of such specifications shall be kept in the office of the Village Clerk for examination by persons interested.

Pipe used in plumbing work shall conform to such specifications as may be approved from time to time by ordinance. (M.C. 1949, Sec. 529)

4-6-5: STANDARDS: All work done on any plumbing system shall be performed in an efficient and workmanlike manner, and materials used shall be standard, adequate to the purpose, and of what is generally considered standard material. (M.C. 1949, Sec. 530)

4-6-6: PENALTY: Any person violating any provision of this Chapter shall be fined not less than twenty five dollars (\$25.00) nor more than two hundred dollars (\$200.00) for each offense; and a separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day during or on which a violation occurs or continues. (M.C. 1949, Sec. 531; amd. Ord. 338, 1-3-77)
