

CHAPTER 6

CURFEW

SECTION:

- 6-6-1: Curfew Established
- 6-6-2: Parents; Responsibility
- 6-6-3: Penalty

6-6-1: CURFEW ESTABLISHED: It shall be unlawful for a person less than eighteen (18) years of age to be present at or upon any public assembly, building, place, street or highway at the following times unless accompanied and supervised by a parent, legal guardian or other responsible companion at least twenty one (21) years of age approved by a parent or legal guardian or unless engaged in a business or occupation which the laws of the State of Illinois authorize a person less than eighteen (18) years of age to perform:

Between 12:01 A.M. and 6:00 A.M. Saturday  
Between 12:01 A.M. and 6:00 A.M. Sunday; and  
Between 11:00 P.M. on Sunday to Thursday, inclusive, and 6:00 A.M. on the following day.

6-6-2: PARENTS' RESPONSIBILITY: It shall be unlawful for a parent, legal guardian or other person to knowingly permit a person in his custody or control to violate Section 6-6-1 hereof.

6-6-3 PENALTY: A person convicted of a violation of any provision of this Chapter shall be fined not less than fifty dollars (\$50.00) nor more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00). (Ord. 256, 6-20-66; amd. Ord. 338, 1-3-77)

In the event a person is accused of a violation of the preceding section and does not wish to contest said allegation prior to the time a complaint is issued for the violation, then said person so accused may pay to the Village, at the Village Hall, a penalty in the sum of fifty dollars (\$50.00) for an in full satisfaction of said violation.
