

CHAPTER 7

DRIVERS

SECTION:

- 9-7-1: Age Limit
- 9-7-2: Liquor, Drugs
- 9-7-3: Accidents
- 9-7-4: Penalty

9-7-1: AGE LIMIT: It shall be unlawful for any person under fifteen (15) years of age to operate any motor vehicle upon the streets of the Village. (M.C. 1949, Sec. 415)

9-7-2: LIQUOR; DRUGS: It shall be unlawful for the habitual user of narcotic drugs to operate any motor vehicle in any street; and it shall be unlawful for any intoxicated person, or any person under the influence of alcoholic liquor or of a narcotic drug, to operate or attempt to operate any motor vehicle on any street. (M.C. 1949, Sec. 416)

9-7-3: ACCIDENTS: It shall be unlawful for the driver of a vehicle which has collided with any vehicle, person or property in such a manner as to cause injury or damage, to fail or refuse to stop immediately to render such assistance as may be possible, to give his true name to the injured person or the owner of the property damaged, and to a policeman if one is present. A report of each accident shall be given to the Chief of Police by the driver of each vehicle concerned in it, within twenty four (24) hours. (M.C. 1949, Sec. 417)

9-7-4: PENALTY: Any person violating any provision of this Title shall be fined not less than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) nor more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00) for each offense; and a separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day during or on which a violation occurs or continues. (M.C. 1949, Sec. 418; amd. Ord. 338, 1-3-77)
